SUGAR (PRICE DETERMINATION OF 1990-91 PRODUCTION) ORDER, 1990

G.S.R. 856(E)/Ess. Com./Sugar, dated the 23rd October, 1990. 1 -In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (3-C) of Sec. 3 of the Essential Commodities Act, 1955 (10 of 1955), the Central Government hereby makes the following Order, namely:

1. Short title and commencement :-

- (1) This Order may be called the Sugar (Price Determination for 1990-91 Production) Order, 1990.
- (2) It shall come into force at once.

2. Price of sugar produced in 1990-91 season :-

The Central Government hereby determines the prices specified in columns 2 to 5 of Schs. I and II, hereto annexed, as the prices payable for the Indian Sugar Standard (ISS) grades of sugar mentioned therein, packed in 'A' Twill now gunny bags and produced in 1990-91 by all vacuum pan sugar factories situated in the areas specified in the corresponding entry in column I of the said schedules, and specified in Sch. III hereto annexed, and required to be supplied to lhe persons, organisations or Stlate Governments specified in the Order made by the Central Government under sub-clause (1) of Cl. 2 of the Levy Sugar Supply (Control) Order, 1979 for delivery at buyer's option into (i) railway wagons or (ii) the buyer's carts, lorries or other means of transport at the factory gates/factory godown. Provided that where a sugar factory is situated at a dislance exceeding five kilometres from the nearest railway station or an out-agency of the railway or from the godown outside the factory not connected by rail, the producer may charge additional 1 ["seven and a half paise per quintal"] of sugar per kilometre beyond five kilometres of the dislance between the sugar factory and such railway station or outagency of the railway in case of despatches by rail or between the sugar factory and such godown in case of delivery ex-godowns.
