S.O. 202(E), dated 18th March, 1991. 1 -In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 21, read with Section 7 of the Coinage Act, 1906 (3 of 1906) the Central Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement :-

(1) These rules may be called the Coinage (Standard Weight and Remedy of the Commemorative Coins of One Rupee containing Copper 75% and Nickel 25% coined in Commemoration of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centenary) Rules, 1991.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette..

<u>2.</u> Standard weight and remedy allowed on the coins coined in commemoration of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Centenary :-

The Standard Weight of the coins of One Rupee, coined under the provisions of Section 6 of the Coinage Act, 1906 (3 of 1906), and the remedy allowed in the making of such coins shall be as specified in the Table below:
