G. S. R. 289(E), dated 16th March, 1993. 1 -Inexercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of Section 21, read with Section 7 of the Coinage Act, 1906 (3 of 1906), the Central Government hereby makes the following namely::

1. Short title and commencement :-

(1) These rules may be called the Coinage (Standard Weight and Remedy of the Five Rupees coins containing Copper 75 per cent. and Nickel 25 per cent.) Rules, 1993.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the official Gazette.

2. Standard weight and remedy allowed :-

The standard weight of the coin of five rupees coined under the provisions of Section 6 of the Coinage Act, 1906 (3 of 1906), and the remedy allowed in the making of such coin shall be as specified in lfae Table below:
