G.S.R. 577, dated, 5th December, 19961 .- In exercise of the powers conferred by the proviso to Art.309 of the Constitution and in supersession of the Indian Posts and Telegraphs Department (Hindi Translators Grade-I Grade-II, Grade-III and HindiTypists) Recruitment Rules-1983 in so far as they relate to the posts in the Department of Posts, except as respects things done or omitted to be done before such supersession the President hereby makes the following rules regulating the method of recruitment to the posts of Junior Hindi Translator and Senior Hindi Translator in the Department of Posts, namely:-

1. Short title and commencement :-

(1) These rules may be called the Department of Posts (Junior Hindi Translator and Senior Hindi Translator) Recruitment Rules, 1996.

(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gaz.ette.

2. Number of posts, classification and scales of pay :-

The number of the said posts, their classification and scale of pay attached thereto shall be as specified in Columns 2 to 4 of the Schedule annexed to these rules.
